Next Mr. Jim Wood, State Transportation Planning Administrator with the Florida Department of Transportation gave a presentation that provided background on the Future Corridors Initiative and the I-75 Relief Task Force. The I-75 Relief Task Force is currently meeting on the first leg to the Tampa Bay to Northeast Florida Corridor. Mr. Wood handed out to the Committee the Guiding Principles developed by the I-75 Task Force.

Who do you want to hear from? Needs and vision of logistics providers, emergency management, higher education institutions such as UF.

What information do you want? Map of large land holdings and planned development, GIS overlay of COMP Plans & Future Projects, Socio-economic data for addressing social justice and equity issues.
